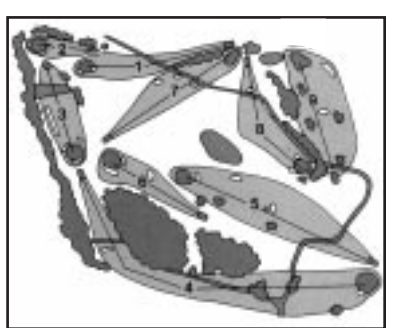
That settles it. See you there.
